
INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The IQAC conducted a two-day online training program on "Learning Management System" during 18.06.2021-19.06.2021. Dr. Moncy Mathew delivered welcome speech to the inaugural session, Dr. Edakkotte Shaji presided over the function and Dr. Sajitha Kizhinippurath express vote of thanks. The LMS team from SNGS College Pattambi handled the sessions, with Dr. H. K. Santhosh, Dr. Kaladharan, and Dr.

Rasheed serving as resource persons. The program provided both theoretical and practical knowledge about the implementation and use of LMS in online education. It was particularly helpful during the COVID pandemic. 90 faculties attended the programme.









